## SEQUENCING:

1. Research \& discuss different art movements and painting styles
2. Choose artist (less visible brushstrokes for more advanced student)
3. Lightly draw outlines, focusing on big shapes and main ideas not small details because they will be painted over. 1-3 class periods.
4. Demo base layers \& painting general to specific details.
5. Copy the painting by focusing on matching the colors and the style/direction of brushstrokes. 3-4 Weeks.
6. Critique $\&$ reflect.
