# SEQUENCING:

**VOCAB:** Intensity

- Review color theory and drawing with colored pencil with color pencil techniques worksheet and color mixing chart.
- 2. Watch demonstration videos.
- 3. Review composition and have students arrange and glue down their candy pieces for their still life.
- 4. Remember what your light source is. You want to have the still life in the same spot every time you draw from it.
- 5. Sketch 3 different cropped compositions before starting the final.
- **LIGHTLY** draw the outlines of your candy 6. composition in pencil. Use LAYERS to build up your colors and values.
- 7. Critique as a class and write self reflections.
